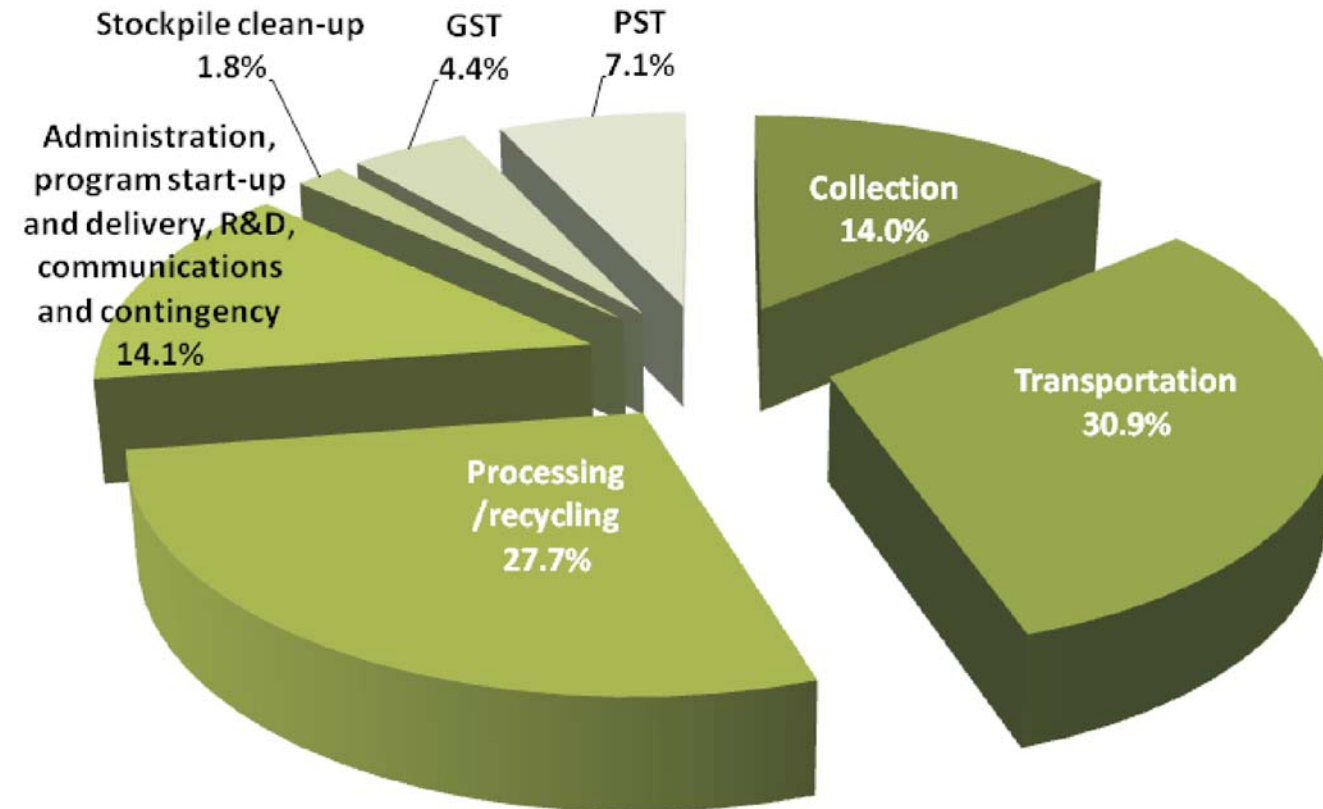
## Tire Stewardship Fees (TSF) for On-Road and Off-Road Vehicle Tires

On September 1, 2009 a new Used Tires Program was launched in Ontario by Ontario Tire Stewardship (OTS) – a not-for-profit industry funding organization operating under the auspices of Waste Diversion Ontario. Under this program tire manufacturers and importers must remit TSF to OTS on each new tire supplied into Ontario. Where tire manufacturers and importers have chosen to charge retailers the TSF separately you will see a line item called "TSF" on your sales receipt.

Where does your \$6.60 per tire go?

### TSF rates per tire

Passenger/Light Truck Tire:	\$5.84
Medium Truck Tire:	\$14.65
Agricultural Drive Tire:	\$15.29
Agricultural Non-drive Front Tire:	\$5.84
Small Off-the-road Tire (OTR), smaller than 23.5R25:	\$22.24
Medium OTR, between 23.5R25 and 33”:	\$97.30
Large OTR, between 33” and 39”:	\$104.25
Giant OTR, larger than 39”:	\$250.20
Solid and Industrial Tire:	\$12.51
Small OTR non-motorized equipment tires:	No TSF
